WHICH COURSES ARE RELEVANT FOR STUDENTS OF ENGLISH-MEDIUM MASTER PROGRAMMES?

- THE ADMISSION LETTER SPECIFIES THAT STUDENTS MUST HAVE CERTIFICATION THAT THEY HAVE REACHED (CEFR) A1 LEVEL GERMAN BY
 THE END OF THEIR FIRST ACADEMIC YEAR. LIKE MANY OTHER UNIVERSITIES, THE LANGUAGE CENTRE OF THE UBT OFFERS TWO
 CONSECUTIVE COURSES WHICH LEAD TO A1 LEVEL (AI.1 AND A1.2)
- INFO CONCERNING THE A1.1 (GRUNDKURS 1) IS AVAILABLE HERE. REGISTRATION STARTS ON 18.04. AT 13:00
- INFO CONCERNING THE A1.2 (GRUNDKURS 2) IS AVAILABLE HERE. REGISTRATION STARTS ON 18.04. AT 13:00 YOU CANNOT REGISTER FOR A1.2 DIRECTLY (SEE NEXT SLIDE).

WHEN AND HOW OFTEN ARE THESE COURSES OFFERED?

- BOTH COURSES (A1.1 AND A1.2) ARE OFFERED DURING THE SEMESTER (SEVERAL PARALLEL COURSES) AND DURING THE SEMESTER BREAK (ONE COURSE EACH) SO THAT IT IS POSSIBLE FOR STUDENTS TO COMPLETE A1 LEVEL BY THE END OF THEIR FIRST ACADEMIC YEAR.
- OPTION 1 (STANDARD TRACK): A1.1 IN SEMESTER #1 AND A1.2 IN SEMESTER #2
- OPTION 2 (TURBO TRACK): A1.1 DURING SEMESTER #1 AND A1.2 DURING THE SEMESTER BREAK (SEMESTER #1)
- THE DATES OF THE BLOCK COURSES APPEAR ON CMLIFE AND THE SZ PAGE FROM MID-JUNE / MID-DECEMBER.

STUDENTS WITH NO/SOME KNOWLEDGE SPRACHENZEN UNIVERSITÄT BAYREUTH **GERMAN**



- STUDENTS WITH **NO PRIOR KNOWLEDGE** OF GERMAN CAN REGISTER FOR A1.1/GRUNDKURS 1 VIA CMLIFE. REGISTRATION OPENS 18.04. AT 13:00
- STUDENTS WITH **PRIOR KNOWLEDGE CANNOT REGISTER** DIRECTLY FOR A COURSE (A1.2 OR HIGHER)
 - -THEY MUST SUBMIT AN OFFICIAL CERTIFICATE OR FIRST TAKE A PLACEMENT TEST.

Official certificate (TestDaF certificate, Goethe-Institut certificate, IIK Bayreuth (A1 only), TELC, DSH)

If a student holds one of these certificates and it is **not older than 2 years,** they can upload it through our <u>form service</u>. They will then be exempted from the test and can register for the higher level courses via CMLife. Registration opens on 18 April at 13:00

Placement test (This is not an official certificate exam!)

If the student some knowledge of German but no official certification of their language level OR if they hold a certificate that is older than 2 years, they have to take our placement test. Details: here. Registration for the placement test: via CMLife from 9.04-16.04.

LATE-ARRIVALS

- STUDENTS WHO ARRIVE LATE ON CAMPUS AND CAN PROVIDE DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE OF THIS CAN REGISTER FOR COURSES UP TO
 ONE MONTH AFTER CLASSES BEGIN (17 OF MAY 2024) PROVIDED THERE ARE SUFFICIENT PLACES AVAILABLE
- THEY MUST PROVIDE PROOF OF THEIR LATE ARRIVAL VIA THE SZ'S FORM SERVICE.
- ON APPROVAL, STUDENTS WILL BE ADMITTED TO THE COURSE. MISSED HOURS MUST BE MADE UP THROUGH THE 'LANGUAGE LOUNGE RECOVERY PROGRAM' FURTHER DETAILS: HERE.

SPECIAL FEATURES OF COURSES AT THE LANGUAGE CENTRE

- ATTENDANCE IS COMPULSORY. IN 4 SWS COURSES, STUDENTS MAY ONLY MISS FOUR SESSIONS WITHOUT AN EXCUSE.
- COURSE REGISTRATION AUTOMATICALLY INCLUDES REGISTRATION FOR THE FINAL EXAM AT THE END OF THE COURSE.
- IF A STUDENT DOES NOT COMPLETE A COURSE `N.E., 5,0' IS ENTERED AS THEIR COURSE RESULT BUT THIS HAS NO NEGATIVE REPERCUSSSIONS: (A) THE COURSE CAN BE TAKEN AGAIN (B) DROPPED/FAILED COURSES DO NOT APPEAR ON STUDENTS' FINAL TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS
